FINANCIAL AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR NH FAMILIES WITH YOUNG CHILDREN

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF)

TANF provides financial assistance through the Family Assistance Program (FAP), and financial assistance and employment and training services through the New Hampshire Employment Program (NHEP), to families with dependent children to help them become self-supporting.

CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES

This program locates absent parents, establishes paternity and support orders, and enforces child support orders. Services are provided whether the absent parent lives in New Hampshire or out of state. Any parent living with a child is eligible to apply for and receive any or all child support services.

MEDICAID

Medicaid pays for health care costs, such as prenatal care, well childcare, doctor and hospital bills, dental care for children, and prescriptions. Pregnant women and children through age 18 may have higher incomes and still be eligible.

FOOD STAMP PROGRAM

The Food Stamp Program allows eligible households to buy more food of greater variety to improve their daily food intake. Eligibility is based on a household's income, resources, and expenses.
